OAKLAND SYMPHONY VOLUNTEERS ARE RECOGNIZED AS "MOST VALUABLE PLAYERS" AT THE ASSOCIATION OF CALIFORNIA SYMPHONY ORCHESTRAS' 48TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Harry Howe and Inge Wells, two volunteers for the Oakland Symphony, were awarded the **Most Valuable Player Award** at the Association of California Symphony Orchestras' (ACSO) Conference in Oakland on August 6, 2016. The awards presentation was part of ACSO's 48th Annual Conference, which took place August 4– August 6, 2016, at the Oakland Marriott City Center, hosted by the Oakland Symphony. More than 240 orchestra trustees, volunteers, musicians, conductors, and staff members came together for three days of networking, panels, peer forums, and musical events.

Initiated in 1996, the Most Valuable Player Awards were created to recognize exemplary volunteers, volunteer projects, and volunteer organizations working for California's symphony orchestras and choruses. A total of nine awards were presented at the ceremony, representing volunteers from orchestras from all budget categories throughout California.
