### DIRECTIONS TO PARAMOUNT THEATRE

**From San Francisco:** Cross the Bay Bridge. Take 580 East to the 980/Downtown Oakland exit. Proceed on 980 to the 27<sup>th</sup> Street/West Grand exit. At the bottom of the exit, cross 27<sup>th</sup> street and proceed straight ahead to West Grand. Take a left on West Grand. Go one block to Telegraph. Take a right on Telegraph. Proceed two blocks and take a left on 21<sup>st</sup> Street.

**From Berkeley:** Take I-80 west. Follow 580 East to the 980/Downtown Oakland exit and then proceed as above.

**From Walnut Creek/Concord:** Take 24 west through the Caldecot Tunnel. Take the 980/Downtown Oakland exit and proceed as above.

**From Hayward:** Take 580 west to the 980/Downtown Oakland exit and proceed as above.

### PARKING:

The Paramount is located on the corner of 21<sup>st</sup> Street and Broadway. There is a public parking garage directly across the street from the stage door entrance (entrance off Telegraph). This is a public lot and there is a parking fee on event days – event parking fee is \$12 (recommended for safety and comfort). Street parking on Sunday should be possible. There is also the BART station at 19<sup>th</sup> street (one block from the theatre). There is a pay lot on Webster (between Grand and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street) that is very reasonably priced on Sundays (no guard on the premises).
