Duties and responsibilities:

- Track volunteer benefits and hours in database
- Procure via email the number of volunteers needed for activities for Development, Marketing, other as needed; follow up with several emails to keep track of them and keep them up to date about the upcoming activity
- Coordinate events tied to donor recognition and cultivation
- Manage volunteers for development-related mailings and special events
- Provide volunteer stories and profiles to Marketing Director for us on website and newsletters
- Be a helpful member of a dynamic administrative team which supports the programs of Oakland Symphony, Oakland Symphony Youth Orchestra, Oakland Symphony Chorus

Requirements:

- Procure food and beverages for events, whether it be by locating an appropriate caterer, or buying, transporting and preparing the food myself or with the help of volunteer(s)
- Doing table and chair set up at events for volunteers as needed, plus takedown and clean-up as needed, and managing volunteer(s) who assist in this
- Procure in-kind donations for volunteer recognition awards and prizes, and manage volunteers who do the same in our name
- Track comp tickets due to each volunteer for their work
- Create fliers, posters, raffle tickets and other materials to advertise the volunteer opportunities

- Send out thank you letters or emails to volunteers after each event
- Procure volunteers for additional Oakland Symphony events as needed
